

Families in Transition Program (FIT): Building Brighter Futures Through Family Development

FIT is a fund that primarily addresses the financial challenges that some CFEC parents face in their efforts to support their families, while attending school. In the past financial support has been provided for rent, school supplies for children, clothing, groceries, prescriptions, and scholarships for graduating parents and youth. In addition to this we currently we provide bus passes for 8 secondary school children, whose parents are in our programs.

The FIT fund provides those essential wrap-around provisions that families need in order to build a brighter future for their kids. Our appeal for donations is targeted to support the families in CFEC's programs as they complete high school and/or help our new immigrants/refugees make the transition to a new life in Canada. By giving them a hand up we provide a bridge of sorts until they get back on their feet.
